**AMENDMENT TO
GENERAL ORDER NO. 94**

General Order No. 94 is amended as follows:

Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1007-1 is amended to provide:

- (e) If a debtor fails to file the Statement of Social Security Number required by Bankruptcy Rule 1007(f) with the petition, the debtor shall have five calendar days from the date of the filing of the petition to file the statement. Failure to file the statement within 5 calendar days of the filing of the petition shall be cause for dismissal of the petition. In place of submitting a Statement of Social Security Number, the attorney for the debtor may submit the debtor's social security number electronically when filing the petition and opening the case on CM/ECF and include in the Declaration Re: Electronic Filing debtor's declaration that the social security number is true and correct.

1 (f) A chapter 7 individual debtor who is not required to file a Statement of
2 Current Monthly Income and Means Test Calculation because his or her
3 debts are not primarily consumer debts shall file a statement to that
4 effect.
