8 This order amends Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1006-
9 1 by adding the following provisions:

10 (a)(3)(A)(i) Chapter 7, 11, 12 and 13 Individual Voluntary
11 Cases.

12 If an individual debtor files a bankruptcy petition
13 without payment of the full filing fee, a minimum payment of \$50.00
14 must accompany the petition. If the debtor is unable to make the
15 initial payment at the time of filing, an order will be entered
16 requiring the debtor to make the initial payment of \$50.00 within
17 fifteen (15) days of the entry of the order and providing that the
18 case shall be dismissed without further notice if the payment is not
19 made within the time specified.

20 (a)(3)(A)(ii)

21 Only an individual debtor may file an application and be
22 permitted to pay the filing fee in installments. Corporations,
23 partnerships, limited liability companies, unincorporated
24 associations and other artificial entities shall pay the filing fee
25 in full at the time the petition is filed.

26 (a)(4)(B)

27 If the debtor files a case without payment of the full
28 filing fee when the debtor owes a filing fee from a prior case, an

1 order will be entered requiring that the debtor shall pay the entire
2 filing fee in full within fifteen (15) days of the entry of that
3 order and providing that if said payment is not timely made, the
4 debtor's case shall be dismissed without further notice.

5 (a)(4)(C)

6 Until the filing fee is paid in full, the debtor shall not
7 pay and no person shall accept any money for services in connection
8 with this case, and the debtor shall not relinquish, and no person
9 shall accept any property as payment for services in connection with
10 this case.
