6. DEADLINE FOR BANKRUPTCY CODE 1111(B) ELECTION:

Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, the conclusion of the Disclosure Statement Hearing is the deadline for a secured creditor to make a written election to have its claim treated pursuant to Bankruptcy Code Section 1111(b)(2).

7. **SERVICE OF THIS ORDER**:

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Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3017(a), the Proponent shall serve a copy of this Order on all creditors and interested parties.

- 8. SERVICE OF THE DISCLOSURE STATEMENT AND PLAN: Pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3017(a), in addition to this Order, the Proponent shall serve copies of the Disclosure Statement and the Plan on:
 - a. the Debtor, unless it is the Proponent;
 - b. any committee appointed pursuant to § 1102 of the Bankruptcy Code;
 - the Securities and Exchange Commission, Attn: Bankruptcy Counsel, 444 S. Flower Street, Suite 900, Los Angeles, CA 90071;
 - d. the United States trustee; and,
 - e. any party in interest that has requested or requests in writing a copy of the Disclosure Statement and Plan.
- 9. **REQUEST FOR COPIES**: Any creditor or party in interest may obtain a copy of the Disclosure Statement and Plan by sending a written request for the copies to the Proponent
