10	The court has considered the appointed representatives' request for the appointment of		
11	professional consultants, whose assistance is sought in an effort to estimate the statistical probability in		
12	both number and amount of future and unknown claims of the affected groups.		
13	Upon consideration of the status of the entire case, including the number of claims actually		
14	filed herein, the cost of such professionals, and the recognition that, in the end, the estimations are		
15	nothing more than that, the court concludes that the application should be denied.		
16	Moreover, the court also finds and concludes that the appointed representatives have		
17	appropriate training and skill to undertake this process without costing the estate such a large		
18	administrative expense. Indeed, each of the appointed representatives are attorneys with		
19	approximately 35 years each of practice experience, and are uniquely suited to the task of estimating the		
20	potential and size of such unknown claims.		
21	In an effort to assist all parties in making these estimates, and without suggesting that this		
22	is the only way to deduce answers to this problem, the court recommends taking the following approach,		
23	at least as a primitive starting point.		
24	Using the discovery tools available under Fed.R.Bankr.P. 9014 (incorporating		
25	Fed.R.Civ.P. 26-31), the Debtor should answer, under oath, the following questions:

1	1.	List all priests employed by, or in the service of, the Diocese, from 1950
2		to the present, together with their years of service and parishes served.
3	2.	State the approximate population of each parish at the time each priest
4		served it.
5	3.	From that list, identify each priest against whom any claim of sexual
6		misconduct or abuse was made, no matter how minor the incident.
7	4.	As to each such priest, describe where such information was obtained
8		(e.g., files, letters, other documents, etc.).
9	5.	As to each incident, describe the nature of the grievance, and the name and
10		age of the alleged victim at the time of the incident.
11	6.	As to each incident, evaluate how (i.e., in what "tier," 1 - 4) such claim
12		would be treated in the current plan of reorganization.
13	7.	As to each incident, describe whether the incident was resolved, whether
14		by monetary or non-monetary means (e.g., apology, etc.).
15	8.	Describe all monetary settlements made by the Diocese, from 1950 to the
16		present, by amount.
17	9.	Describe all verdicts rendered by a court of law, after trial or summary
18		judgment, relative to any of the priests listed.
19	10	For each priest against whom a charge or allegation of sexual misconduct
20		was made, describe the time period from the first to the last allegation.
21	11.	Describe how many offending priests, or those alleged to have committed
22		such sexual offenses, were dealt with by the criminal justice system and
23		how.
24	The c	ourt-appointed representatives are, by no means, limited to these questions in their
25	effort to evaluate the	probability of future claims.
