Notice to All Counsel, Pro Se Parties, and Court Participants: Please be advised that, effective November 3, 2025, all hearings, **except** Reaffirmation Agreement Hearings, before Judge Gan will be in-person proceedings. Reaffirmation Agreement Hearings will continue to be held via videoconference.

For all hearings other than reaffirmation hearings, remote video appearances will be allowed for participants located outside of the Tucson metropolitan area.

Parties are directed to review the case docket to confirm the manner in which the Court will conduct a specific hearing. Videoconference participants are encouraged to review the <u>Videoconference Hearing Guidelines</u> posted at the Court's website.

Key Changes:

- In-Person Attendance: Tucson counsel and Tucson pro se parties must appear in-person for hearings unless the Court orders otherwise.
- Virtual Viewing: Virtual or remote calendar calls and hearings will typically no longer be available as a matter of course for Tucson counsel and Tucson pro se parties.

Important Note:

• While this announcement signals a return to all in-person proceedings, remote participation for case participants may still be allowed for specific case matters at the Court's discretion.
