PROHIBITION OF COVERT RECORDING DEVICES IN BANKRUPTCY COURTS

GENERAL ORDER 25-1

Devices that may be used for covert recording are prohibited in all publicly-accessible areas of the United States Bankruptcy Court in Phoenix, the United States Bankruptcy Court in Tucson and the United States Bankruptcy Court in Yuma. This prohibition also extends to all portions of the AWD Professional Building in Flagstaff and the Mohave County Superior Court in Bullhead City when occupied by the United States Bankruptcy Court. Prohibited devices include but are not limited to USB mini voice recorders, camera and voice recorder pens, and smart glasses.
