
VERSION 3 TRANSFER/ASSIGNMENT OF CLAIMS PROCESS – ATTORNEY/CLAIMS FILER INSTRUCTIONS 8/14/2006

1. When filing an Assignment/Transfer of Claim (with or without a waiver of notice), Version 3 of CM/ECF has a new transfer of claim process that will result in the assignment/transfer both being filed and docketed in the BK case and also being cross-referenced on the claims register in a new claims history section.



2. While you may select a Transfer type, it is not required. The Transfer types are:




3. The transferee (assignee), the person or entity to whom the claim was transferred or assigned, is to be selected from the creditor list. First click on Search Creditors, if the transferee is not on the creditor list, which is likely, then the transferee is to be added using the Add New Creditor button.


4. The transferor (assignor), the person or entity that is transferring/assigning its claim, is to be selected from the creditor list. If the transferor is not on the creditor list, there is no option to add the transferor to the list. If the transferor is not on the creditor list, then the transferor has neither filed a proof of claim in the case nor been listed as a creditor by the debtor. In such a case, the transfer of claim will not able to be filed using this process. Instead, the transferee/assignee must file its own proof of claim and you may attach a copy of the transfer or assignment to the claim.



If the transferor is listed on the creditor list but has not filed a proof of claim, the following warning will be displayed. While you may proceed to file the transfer using this process, you also need to file a proof of claim or you may cancel this filing and the transferee then file a proof of claim in its name, attaching a copy of the transfer.



You can tell if the transferor has filed a claim or not as the claim number is referenced on the creditor list.



If as transferee, you have had more than one claim in the case transferred to you, you may file more than one using this entry (be sure that when you uploaded the pdf document that you uploaded the transfer documents for all the transfers being done in this entry.)

5. While the transferee normally files the transfer/assignment, the transferor can file it for the transferee. The docket text simply states that the transfer was filed and states the transferee and transferor without stating who filed it.

Assignment/Transfer of Claim with Waiver of Notice Transferor: ABC BANK (Claim No. 1) To EFC COMPANY (Christensen, Toni) (Entered: 07/17/2006)

The person who did the filing is identified in the docket entry in parenthesis at the end of the entry.

6. The claims register will substitute the transferee as the creditor for claim number 4.
