
GENERAL ORDER
NO. 105

10 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1006-1(d)(2) is
11 amended and replaced by the following language:

12 For attorney electronic filings that require a fee, the fee shall be paid by using a credit
13 card or debit card on-line through the ECF Internet filing fee payment process no later than 72
14 hours from the filing of the document. The credit card or debit card used to pay the filing fee
15 must be that of the attorney or law firm that represents the party; use of a party's credit card or
16 debit card is prohibited. A document, other than a petition, electronically filed that requires a
17 filing fee shall be deemed lodged, and not filed, and no further action shall be taken until the
18 filing fee is paid. Failure to appropriately pay the filing fee constitutes good cause for the clerk
19 to suspend the filer's ECF password until such time as all outstanding fees are paid.

20 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of
21 Arizona adopts the amendment to Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 1006-1(d)(2), effective
22 the date of this General Order.
